- LADIES DAY TEE TIME BLOCKS ARE 8:30 10:30am and 2:30 6:00pm
- Ballots will be used for Tuesday Tee Times and the Pro Shop will make up the DRAW and Post
- Ballots (sample below) can be entered either at the Pro Shop or Online
- Ballots can include single name, a twosome, a threesome, a foursome or multiple names grouped on several ballots stapled together Special Tuesday Ballot Box will be in the Pro Shop

- Groups may play with combinations of both Orange and Red Tee participants, but each have to declare the tee to play before starting
- Please ensure you check into the Pro Shop before Teeing Off
- \$5.00 Entry Fee per participant Prizes will be awarded by Calloway Scoring System Only for FRONT 9 scores
- Scorecards are to be returned to the Pro Shop after your round as the Shop will be doing the scoring
