Fellow Golfers

I would like to welcome all the golfers back for another exciting and interesting year. There have been a lot of changes to the course and planned changes for the clubhouse, which have already been started. All the positive changes will add more prestige to being a member of the Prince George Golf and Curling Club.

This year the Men's Club Championship will be a true club championship. We will be making the second qualifying rounds true qualifying rounds; i.e., after all entries are received the top 32 golfers (by handicap) will be trying to qualify for 16 positions in the championship flight. For the 16 who don't qualify, this will be the end of the club championship for them. The next 32 golfers will qualify for 16 positions for the first flight and 16 will not play any further. This process will go on down the entry list by 32 per flight.

In a nutshell, we will be forming flights of 32 players for the qualifying rounds of which only 16 will go on to play in the club championship. This should eliminate the numerous complaints of golfers playing in a flight with much higher handicap and at the same time it will give the qualifying rounds some true meaning.

I am looking forward to a great season and wish you all the best in 1991.

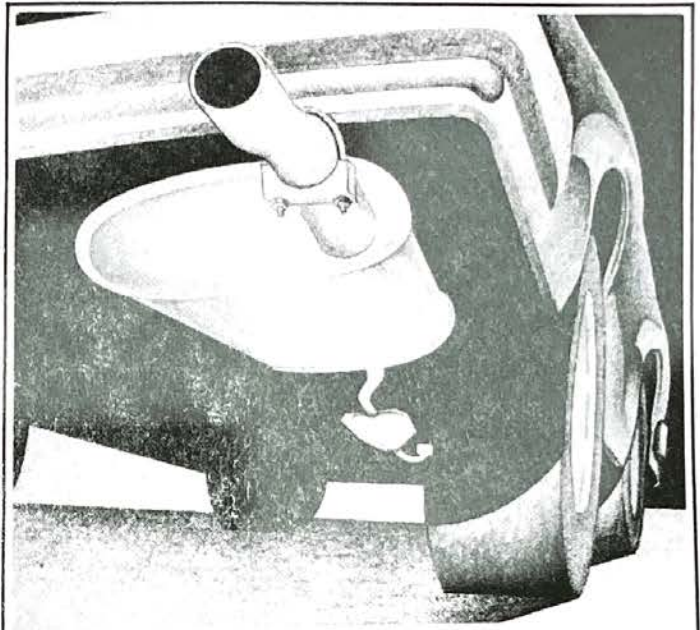

On behalf of the Board of Directors, I would like to take this opportunity to thank you in advance for your cooperation and for helping Laurie Pierce and his staff administer this new policy.



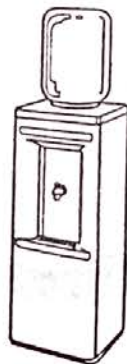
